

Open Position

Repair Technician:

This position will work with our current repair techs on 1st shift at our Repair Facility at 700 Greene 736 Road. Hours are generally 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Overtime will be required at times including Saturday. This position will report to the Repairs Manager.

Job Description:

This job is to repair, refurbish, and rebuild concrete equipment with gasoline and diesel engines. These units will have mechanical drive and hydraulic drive systems that will need to be repaired. Other general labor tasks will also be required.

Job Duties:

- Follow the Repair Manager's instructions for daily duties.
- Unload machines from trucks and trailers to be looked at.
- Clean machines before repair begins.
- Repair and replace any defective part on units to be repaired.
- Refurbish and rebuild machines and parts.
- Test and adjust machines after repaired.
- Work with other team members to get job completed.
- Help with packing and shipping machines and items out to customers.

Skills Required:

- General-to-above average mechanical skills.
- Have forklift license or the ability to get one.
- Proficiency in problem solving.
- Excellent verbal, written and interpersonal communication skills.
- Ability to multitask in a fast paced environment.
- Ability to assist in resolving technical issues.
- Willing to work with others
- Must possess general hydraulic and electrical knowledge.
- Must have a willingness to adapt to last minute changes in the schedule.

Other:
